

GIBSON COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ORDINANCE NO. 2024- 2

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE STORMWATER FEE SCHEDULE

WHEREAS, Indiana Code 36-1-3, which is commonly known as the “home rule”, provides that local governments (such as counties, cities, and towns) have the authority to pass legislation not specifically prohibited by federal or state rules and regulations;

WHEREAS, this Ordinance supersedes all prior Ordinances, Resolutions, or approved Motions previously passed by the Gibson County Commissioners that conflict with this Ordinance; however, all prior legislation (approved Motions, Resolutions, and Ordinances) not conflicted by this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect;


WHEREAS, this legislation was passed at a meeting conducted by the Gibson County Commissioners; said meeting was in compliance with the public meetings law, which is codified in Indiana Code 5-14-1.5;

WHEREAS, the Gibson County Commissioners wish to increase the drainage review base fees imposed for commercial and industrial sites; said increase would modify the fees contained in Ordinance 2022-3.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GIBSON COUNTY COMMISSIONERS THAT:

1. The drainage review base fees for commercial and industrial sites shall hereinafter be as follows:
 - 1.1. One (1) to less than two (2) acres - \$3,000
 - 1.2. Two (2) to less than seven (7) acres - \$3,400
 - 1.3. Eight (8) to less than twenty (20) acres - \$3,800
 - 1.4. Twenty plus (20+) acres - \$4,300 + \$100 per acre for every acre after the first 20 acres
2. This Ordinance shall be effective from and after adoption by this Board of Commissioners and compliance with Indiana Code 36-2-4-8.
